This position will involve the management, collection, and interpretation of data from geological mapping, drilling, geophysical and geochemical programs. This position will work a **local 4x3 10.5-hour schedule** offering a great work/life balance.

What you'll do

- Collect and interpret exploration data from drilling, geophysical, geochemical, and geological mapping programs.
- Conduct field geological mapping, drill-hole logging, stream sediment, soil and rock chip geochemical sampling and geophysical program management.
- Perform integrated interpretation of geological, geochemical, and geophysical data to understand the significance of results, and to assist in target definition and follow-up program design.
- Work closely with field assistants to collect and compile data, manage parts of programs and ensure that a safe work environment is maintained.
- Compile government mandated geological reporting and environmental reporting.
- Support the cultural heritage, community relations and environmental management implications of exploration activities.
- Interpret and validate geological, geochemical, and geophysical data to update geological models to assist in target generation.
- Minimize company risk exposure and liabilities by monitoring activities to ensure compliance with all statutory, regulatory and licensing requirements.
