Pollution Incident Response Management Plan



This Pollution Incident Response Management Plan has been made publicly available, as per Clause 98D of the Protection of the Environment Operations (General) Regulation 2009 and the *Protection of the Environment Operations Act* 1997 (the POEO Act). The following represents an extract from the CGO Emergency Preparedness and Response Plan (CGO ERT MPL 0002), published December 2022.

For the purpose of this plan a 'pollution incident' is defined as:

"An occurrence or set of circumstances during or as a consequence of which there is or is likely to be a leak, spill or other escape or deposit of a substance, as a result of which pollution has occurred, is occurring or is likely to occur. It includes an incident or set of circumstances in which a substance has been placed or disposed of on premises, but it does not include an incident or set of circumstances involving only the emission of any noise" (POEO Act).

Notification of Pollution Incidents:

In the case of an emergency, Cowal Gold Operations will contact the Emergency Services immediately on 000.

After Emergency Services have been contacted, or in the case of non-emergency pollution incidents*, Cowal Gold Operations will notify the Authorities outlined in Table 1 and 2 as required.

Contacting Neighbours and Surrounding Communities:

For pollution incidents that extend beyond site boundaries and which cause, or threaten to cause, harm to people, property or the environment, Cowal Gold Operations will seek the advice of the Emergency Services and Authorities to notify all relevant neighbours by a suitable method appropriate to the situation. The neighbours that have been identified as those most likely to be impacted by a pollution incident are outlined in Table 2 and CGO_ERT_MPL_0002.

(Clause 1, Section 147, POEO 1997)
